HOW TO ACCESS OUR SERVICE?

Central Queensland Rural Health (CQRH) is a not for profit service providing quality mental health care within Central Queensland, Central Highlands and North Burnett regions.

We offer care to all ages and can provide services via telehealth where needed.

Private Fee

We offer a private service via a GP referral or self referral.

Private Health Rebates may be available. Please contact your provider to find out if you are eligible

Workcover

We are an approved Workcover provider. If you require services, please contact our offices to discuss how we can support you.

Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

We are available to contract to Employers for Employee Assistance Programs.

NDIS Services

CQRH are able to provide mental health services through the NDIS if your are Plan Managed or Self Managed and if the plan includes "Improved Daily Living Skills" and psychology services align with your goals.

Subsidised services
